## **Cleveland Ohio USBC Mixed City Tournament Rules**

- ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENT: This tournament is USBC certified and is open to all participants belonging to the Cleveland Ohio USBC Association (COUSBC). Non-members may enter by purchasing an associate membership for \$25.00 or paying local association dues of \$11 on site, if they are members of another association.
- 2. The tournament shall consist of a four (4) person team, two (2) women and two (2) men. Doubles event, one (1) woman, one (1) man, singles event and all event. Singles event will be bowled first then the doubles event.
- 3. Multiple participation will be permitted in each event. No more than two (2) players on a team can place more than once in the prize list for position standings. When a bowler competes more than once their first appearance in each event shall count toward their all events score. In the doubles event, bowlers can cash only once with the same partner. In the singles event bowlers can only cash once. Prize ratio is 1 out of 7 will cash handicap and 1 out of 10 will cash scratch.
- 4. Check in will be 30 minutes prior to squad time. Squad time is 8:00 am Singles/Doubles and 11:30 pm Team. Walk-ins are permitted one (1) hour prior to squad time and must pay a \$10 late fee per event. (Based on lane availability). Everyone must check in.
- 5. AVERAGE RULE: All individuals must enter at their highest certified average from previous year 2018-19 of twenty-one (21) games or more. This includes summer or composite averages. If no average for 2018-19, then bowler may use their current average of 21 games or more. If current average is used the average must be VERIFIED in writing by the League Secretary or bring most current standing sheet with name and average clearly printed. If bowler has no current average then 230 average will be used.
- 6. HANDICAP will be 90% of 230. Team method will be used. (Team event: 90% of 920) (Doubles event: 90% of 460) (Singles event: 90% of 230) Handicap game will not exceed 300 and handicap series will not exceed 900.
- 7. USBC certified Tournament Rules 319e, 319a1, 319a3, and 319d is in effect during tournament competition. USBC rule 303 will apply. (Authority of Tournament Management). For complete rules see USBC Playing Rule Book.
- 8. PBA CARD CARRIERS: All bowlers who are PBA or PWBA card carriers at time of bowling are limited to one (1) on team and one (1) on a doubles team line up. The PBA or PWBA card carrier shall be eligible to enter singles and all events.
- 9. Entry fees may be paid by cash, check or money order made payable to Cleveland Ohio USBC Association (COUSBC). A \$40 charge will be assessed to any check returned unpaid. Only cash will be accepted for unpaid checks. No refunds.
- 10. Teams who want to cross lanes together must send completed entry forms and fees in the same envelope. Entries must be postmarked by January 17, 2020. After January 17, 2020 a late fee of \$10 per person, per event will be accessed. (NO EXCEPTIONS)
- 11. All bowlers not ready to bowl when squad begins will receive zero (0) for all frames missed. Tardy bowlers will receive zero (0) for all frames missed.
- 12. Tournament Director decisions are final unless an appeal is made in accordance with Rule 329 filed prior to tournament prize payout.
- 13. Tournament officials will collect all Brackets and Jackpots.
- 14. If a lane malfunction occurs during tournament competition that requires participants to be moved to a new pair of lanes, the participants will start their tournament competition from the point of interruption with NO practice/shadow balls on the new lanes.
- 15. The entrant, by signing their name, hereby agrees that the COUSBC, its officers and agents shall be liable only to the extent of returning the entry fee if and when this entrant shall be prevented from bowling in the tournament through delay, unexpected yet necessary schedule change, or premature termination of the tournament, which may be brought on by war, national emergency or emergencies caused by unexpected weather conditions or causes relating thereto or resulting therefrom fires, strikes, lockouts, labor difficulties or causes beyond the control of the COUSBC.
- 16. ETIQUETTE: Individuals are responsible for their own conduct during tournament competition. Disruptive and unsportsmanlike conduct, profane language and obscene gestures will not be tolerated. The use of artificial devices (headphones) to listen to music or a broadcast is prohibited during competition. Once lane courtesy will be observed by bowlers and enforced throughout the tournament. Failure to comply can result in disqualification from tournament competition.
- 17. Bowling equipment must meet USBC specifications. The use of any powder or foreign substance on shoes, on the approach, on the facility floor, on the carpet, or on a bowling towel is not allowed. Use of all liquids, sprays and sanding pads must be done prior to the first ball of tournament games. No ball surface may be altered after practice has concluded. Once competition begins, only a dry towel may be used to wipe or contact the ball. If a bowler is seen altering a ball surface during the tournament, the ball will be disqualified for the remainder of the tournament as soon as this is discovered. If the bowler incurs a second equipment offense, the bowler will be disqualified from the current event with NO refund of entry fee.
- 18. All entries must be filled out completely on the official entry form and submitted with full payment to Cleveland Ohio USBC Association. Checks/money orders should be payable to COUSBC. Questions should be directed to the COUSBC office at 216-898-9115.
