

### YOUTH DOUBLES TOURNAMENT

1. Participation in COUSBC youth tournaments requires that the youth bowler hold a 2021-22 USBC certification card and bowl in a certified youth league. Bowler certification will be verified via <a href="https://www.bowl.com">www.bowl.com</a>.

- 2. This is a HANDICAP tournament with an <u>optional</u> SCRATCH division (additional fee of \$6.00 per bowler/\$12.00 per team; both team members must enter to be eligible for the scratch option). Handicap is 90% of 440 based on three (3) games. Each bowler will bowl three (3) games league style.
- 3. Each team will consist of any combination of two (2) youth bowlers. Bowlers may bowl twice BUT not on the same team; one youth bowler must be changed.
- 4. Divisions are determined by team average. Bumper bowlers and Special Olympics bowlers will have one division respectively. **Substitutes are permitted.**
- 5. Youth bowlers will use their highest 2020-21 USBC average for 21 games or more unless their 2021-22 average as of October 22, 2021 is ten (10) pins higher, then the higher of the two averages will be used. If the bowler has neither of these averages, he/she will bowl scratch using 220 as the average. Bowlers are responsible for verifying their own average, whether submitted by the bowler, the team captain or other. If the submitted average is lower than reported, the bowler will be disqualified if they do not notify the tournament director before the end of the first game.
- 6. Entry fee is \$50.00 per team (\$25.00/bowler) and is broken down as follows: Lineage \$15.00 (\$7.50); Scholarship \$30.00 (\$15.00); Awards/Expenses: \$5.00 (\$2.50). Entry fee for the scratch option is an additional \$6.00 and is broken down as follows: Scholarship \$5.00; Awards \$1.00. Entry fee for Special Olympics teams is \$24.00 (\$12.00 per bowler) and is broken down as follows: Lineage: \$15.00 (\$7.50); Awards/Expenses: \$9.00 (\$4.50).
- 7. All entries must be filled out completely on the official entry form and submitted with full payment along with standing sheet as of October 22, 2021 showing bowler's full name, number of games, total pins and average. Check or money order should be payable to Cleveland Ohio USBC (COUSBC). Checks returned for non-sufficient funds (NSF) will be charged a \$40.00 fee plus the amount of the check. Only cash will be accepted for NSF checks. All entries mailed to the COUSBC office (14950 Snow Road, Suite 100, ATTN: Youth Department, Brook Park, Ohio 44142) must be postmarked by Wednesday, November 3, 2021. There will be no refunds (exception for COVID-19; see Rule #17). Questions should be directed to the COUSBC office (216-898-9115).
- 8. Walk-ins will be accepted 30 minutes prior to each squad based on lane availability (8:00 AM 8:30 AM & 11:00 AM 11:30 AM).

- 9. Awards will be given to the first (1st) place team in each division at a ratio of 1 in 5 entries or a major fraction thereof (i.e. 2nd place awarded with 8 entries, 3rd place awarded with 13 entries, etc). All award fees will be returned 100% in the form of an award.
- 10. Scholarship money will be awarded to the first (1st) place team in each division at a ratio of 1 in 5 entries or a major fraction thereof (i.e. 2nd place awarded with 8 entries, 3rd place awarded with 13 entries, etc.) with the exception of the Special Olympics division. 100% of all scholarship funds collected from entry fees and additional scholarship resources will be deposited in the USBC SMART Program (Account #10843) for management and disbursal. No cash awards will be given to any bowler. Bowlers can confirm the deposit of scholarship awards by visiting their SMART account statement at <a href="https://www.bowl.com">www.bowl.com</a>.
- 11. All bowlers are expected to be appropriately attired. All bowlers must wear a sleeved shirt. Shorts/skorts (knee length) are permitted. Apparel with reference to tobacco, alcohol and drugs is prohibited. Headwear (hats, headphones, etc.) is not permitted. Bowlers are responsible for their own conduct during tournament competition. Abuse of equipment and foul or disruptive language/behavior by bowlers or spectators is prohibited. Apparel and behavior violations may result in the non-refundable dismissal from participation or attendance at the tournament. The decision of the tournament director is final. One lane courtesy will be observed by bowlers and enforced throughout the tournament.
- 12. No cell phones or music devices are allowed during any competition and includes texting, checking messages, talking on cell phone and listening to music on a device. Bowlers will receive a verbal warning for the first offense; a second offense could lead to disqualification from the event.
- 13. Bowling equipment must meet USBC specifications. The use of any powder or foreign substance on shoes, on the approach, on the facility floor, on the carpet, or on a bowling towel is not allowed. Use of all liquids, sprays and sanding pads must be done prior to the first ball of tournament games. NOTE: Any cleaner that is used prior to the start of competition must be approved by USBC (refer to the "Approved Cleaners" list in the Equipment Specifications manual on <a href="https://www.bowl.com">www.bowl.com</a>) and in its original container which displays the USBC Approved Before/After logo. No ball surface may be altered after practice has concluded (USBC Rule 18). Once competition begins, only a dry towel may be used to wipe or contact the ball. <a href="https://example.com/EXCEPTION FOR THE 2021-2022 SEASON AND UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE: USBC WILL TEMPORARILY ALLOW THE USE OF ISOPROPYL ALCOHOL, AKA RUBBING ALCOHOL, ON THE OUTER SURFACE OF THE BALL AT ANY TIME DURING USBC CERTIFIED COMPETITION. (NOTE: The isopropyl (rubbing) alcohol must be in its original container.) If a bowler is seen altering a ball surface during the tournament, the ball will be disqualified for the remainder of the tournament as soon as this is discovered. If the bowler incurs a second equipment offense, the bowler will be disqualified from the current event with NO refund of entry.</p>
- 14. If a lane malfunction occurs during tournament competition that requires participants to be moved to a new pair of lanes, the participants will start their tournament competition from the point of interruption with no practice/shadow balls on the new lanes.
- 15. The entrant, by signing his/her name, hereby agrees that the COUSBC, its officers and agents shall be liable only to the extent of returning the entry fee if and when this entrant shall be prevented from bowling in the tournament through delay, unexpected yet necessary schedule change, or premature termination of the tournament, which may be brought on by war, national emergency or emergencies caused by unexpected weather conditions or causes relating thereto or resulting therefrom fires, strikes, lockouts, labor difficulties or causes beyond the control of the COUSBC.
- 16. Decisions of the tournament director are final unless an appeal is made in accordance with Rule 329 and is filed within 72 hours of the infraction and/or decision.

#### 17. COVID-19 Precautions

- If you are feeling sick, have a fever over 100 degrees or have come in contact with someone who has had a confirmed case of COVID-19 14 days leading up to this tournament, please contact the COUSBC Office to withdraw from the event. You will receive a full refund.
- The bowling center may require that bowlers wear a face covering at all times in the bowling center except when physically bowling or eating/drinking. If you refuse to wear a face covering or are asked repeatedly to put your mask on, you will be asked to leave the tournament. If you can't wear a mask for health reasons, you must provide a note from a doctor upon arrival.
- Please respect fellow competitors by practicing social distancing
