	TIME REQUESTED UNLESS NOTIFIED OTHERWISE. NO FURTHER NOTIFICATIONS WILL BE SENT. Check in at least forty-five (45) minutes
	before the start of the squad.

- 2. Entrants MUST PRESENT their National 600 Club card and hold a USBC membership in District #2.
- 3. You will bowl four (4) games on assigned lanes and drop your lowest score.
- 4. When more than three or fewer than six games are bowled in a series, ONLY the first three (3) games count for the three-game series USBC awards.
- 5. The Annual Membership dues of the District #2 600 Club of \$3.00 are INCLUDED IN THE ENTRY FEE.
- 6. The Buckeye 600 Bowling Club dues of \$2.00 are INCLUDED IN THE ENTRY FEE.
- MULTIPLE PARTICIPATION: (1) Two (2) Individual reservations; (2) Re-entry. (3) Walk-in. RE-ENTRIES and WALK-INS will be accepted subject to lane availability. Each entry must be paid for, and ONLY CASH will be accepted on the day of bowling. THE PROCESSING FEE FOR WALK-INS IS \$5.00 FOR A TOTAL OF \$45.00 CASH FOR ENTRY, RE-ENTRIES WILL BE \$35.00.
  - 8. Prize fees will be returned 100% on a ratio of at least 1 in 5. In the event of a tie for first place, co-champions will be declared. Awards will be given to the handicapped and the actual winner(s). No individual can win both. In the event one (1) bowler records the winning score for both the handicap and actual series, the high actual award will be given to the individual recording the second-highest actual series. IN NO CASE WILL THE SAME INDIVIDUAL BE ALLOWED TO PLACE MORE THAN ONCE IN THE PRIZE LIST FOR POSITION STANDINGS. Rule 319d is waived (report of prior winnings).
- HANDICAP: Handicap will be 90% based on the average of 220. The maximum game and series total with handicap included are 300 and 900.
- 10. AVERAGE: The highest USBC average in a certified league as of the end of the 2023-24 or 2024-25 season for twenty-one (21) games or more will be used, including SUBSTITUTE AVERAGES. ALL AVERAGES WILL BE VERIFIED ON BOWL.COM. If there is no 2023-24 or 2024-25 book average, the highest USBC certified average for the current season (2025-26) of NINE (9) games as of the time of bowling may be used. CURRENT SEASON AVERAGES MUST BE VERIFIED BY THE LEAGUE SECRETARY. If no average meets these requirements, you must bowl scratch. Failure to use the correct average will disqualify the tournament score if the submitted average is lower than the correct average, resulting in a lower classification or increased handicap. Prize winnings will be issued on the submitted average if it is higher than the correct average. CORRECTIONS in the average will be allowed up to the completion of the first game of the series. Rule 319a-2 is waived (10 over rule). Rule 319e is waived (15 pins over in tournament play rule).
- 11. A substitute will be allowed to bowl if she has the WRITTEN CONSENT of the original entrant.
- 12. No open bowling by any participant on the tournament lanes on any day of the tournament will be allowed.
- 13. This tournament is certified by USBC. All USBC rules will prevail, unless otherwise noted.
- 14. A \$40.00 SERVICE FEE will be charged for checks returned by the bank. All returned checks & service fees must be paid IN CASH before bowling.
- 15. The Board of Directors of the District #2 600 Club has the authority to make decisions regarding anything not covered in these rules.
