



CLEVELAND OHIO USBC HALL OF FAME SUPERIOR PERFORMANCE

The Cleveland Ohio USBC (COUSBC) shall have a Hall of Fame for Superior Performance. In order for an applicant to be considered for candidacy in the COUSBC Hall of Fame for Superior Performance, he/she must meet a minimum of the following qualifications.

Nominees must have:

- Participated in a minimum of fifteen (15) COUSBC (and/or its predecessors) adult city tournaments or its counterpart.
- 1st place title in the scratch/actual division in an adult city, state, regional or national tournament and/or any other adult certified verifiable tournament.
- High average in adult league play in the COUSBC.
- High games (275 or more) and high series (700 / 800 / 900) in adult tournaments or adult league play in the COUSBC.
- COUSBC (and/or its predecessors) adult All-Star Team achievements (refer to the rules for the COUSBC All-Star team).

RULES

1. There shall be no limit to the number of nominees elected to the COUSBC Hall of Fame for Superior Performance.
2. The nominee must have been an adult member of the COUSBC (and/or its predecessors) for at least fifteen (15) years with a minimum of forty-eight (48) games per season in an adult COUSBC **certified** league.
3. Nominees who are currently under suspension are ineligible.
4. Nominees shall continuously be an ambassador in the sport of bowling by exemplifying good character on and off the lanes
5. The above requirements remain subject to waiver by the COUSBC Hall of Fame Committee.
6. A nominee's name may be submitted by any individual for nomination to the COUSBC Hall of Fame.
7. All nominations must be completed annually on the form provided by the COUSBC and submitted no later than February 28th of each year. The envelope should be addressed as follows:

8. All nominations must be submitted with complete and concise records which have been substantiated therein with dates, times, places and scores.

9. In order to be elected to the COUSBC Hall of Fame, a nominee must receive votes from five (5) out of seven (7) members of the COUSBC Hall of Fame Committee. If no nominee receives the required number of votes, no nominee will be elected.
10. The COUSBC Hall of Fame Committee shall be appointed annually by the COUSBC President. The committee is responsible for reviewing applications and then submitting their recommendations to the COUSBC Board of Directors for final approval.
11. Names and qualifications of nominees not elected to the COUSBC Hall of Fame in the year they are submitted will be kept on file for a period of five (5) years and reviewed annually.
12. All nominees will be notified by mail and/or e-mail of the status of their application.
